

Preparing the Bride's and Groom pre room.

The prep room is usually the first venue for photo shooting at the wedding day. Si it needs to reflect the intent and spirit of the Bride and Groom. Here are some tips to make it the best possible venue.

1. Declutter. The room should be free of any unnecessary items (TVs, extra clothing, articles on top of the dresser, items that block the entrance and windows)
(Remember, Less is More)
2. Drapes should be simple and if possible white translucent.
3. Bedding should be simple, white or very light color
4. Remove decorative items from the walls (Pictures, frames, extra mirrors, etc.)
5. Have a clean nice looking mirror on the dresser or make-up table. A full length mirror on a stand in a corner is also a good idea. If possible, have the mirrors match the wedding theme.
6. Having a nice padded white hanger for the bride's dress and a black or brown one for the groom's garments.
7. Lighting. Make sure there is ample natural lighting, if there are chandeliers, lamps or other light factures it is recommended that all bulbs are the same type and intensity and preferable Day-light balance (Fluorescent or LED). This is an inexpensive way to ensure you have the appropriate lighting for your photos. Also a stylish lamp in a small table with white shade and table cloth, and incandescent bulb is recommended for accent.
8. Have a small folding step latter.
9. One or two small flower arrangements that can be moved is also a good idea.
